• The examination fee for the students re-appearing in the end semester examination is ₹ 500/- per subject, with the maximum limit of ₹ 2000/- per semester. Additionally, the practical exam fee is set at ₹ 500/- per semester.

• The examination fee for the students re-appearing in special chance exam is ₹ 5000/- per subject, with the maximum limit of ₹ 7500/- per semester.

• The students enrolled in the **B. Pharmacy programme** (Direct and lateral entry) from the academic session - 2021 and beyond are ineligible for re-appear examinations in odd semesters .However, they retain eligibility for even semesters examination during the end semester examination in December -2023 /January -2024. (Clause no:15 and 16 regarding re-examinations & academic progression of PCI regulation attached for ready reference)

• On-line Examination form shall be enabled w.e.f Nov. 08th, 2023 on the official web site of HP Technical University, Hamirpur i.e. www.himtu.ac.in. The last date of on-line filling of examination form Nov 28th, 2023 (23:59:59 Hrs).

Important Note:


- The Student must ensure that he/she fulfills the eligibility conditions before filling the on-line examination form for the concerned end semester examination. If found in-eligible during scrutiny his/her examination form will be considered as cancel. Examination form once cancelled will not be re-considered and the fee paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- The Principals of all the affiliated colleges must ensure that the students admitted in their college fulfill the eligibility criteria as required under the HPTU norms for respective examination before forwarding the examination forms to the University.
- The regular students must fill in the examination form online and retain the hard copy of the same for his /her record.** Access of the examination forms of the regular students shall be given to the college by the university and the record of filled examination forms of the students will automatically be reflected on the college ID provided by the HPTU. The college may edit/rectify the record, *if required*; verify the examination form of the regular student.
- All the pass out students (Re-appear)** will be given opportunity to opt for the nearest respective HPTU examination centre and the examination centre once allotted to the students shall not be changed. If a student wants to change the examination centre he/she has to apply to the Controller of examination with genuine reason & proof. An amount of ₹ 1000/ will be charged for the change of examination centre
- After the fulfillment of all the Codal formalities re-appear/regular students can directly download his/her admit card.

- I. Multiple Choice Questions(MCQs) = $20 \times 1 = 20$

(Answer all the questions)
- II. Long Answers (Answer 2 out of 3) = $2 \times 10 = 20$
III. Short Answers (Answer 7 out of 9) = $7 \times 5 = 35$

Total = 75 marks

For 50 marks paper

- I. Long Answers (Answer 2 out of 3) = $2 \times 10 = 20$
II. Short Answers (Answer 6 out of 8) = $6 \times 5 = 30$

Total = 50 marks

For 35 marks paper

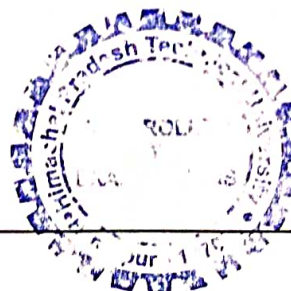
- I. Long Answers (Answer 1 out of 2) = $1 \times 10 = 10$
II. Short Answers (Answer 5 out of 7) = $5 \times 5 = 25$

16. Academic Progression:

No student shall be admitted to any examination unless he/she fulfills the norms given in 6. Academic progression rules are applicable as follows:

A student shall be eligible to carry forward all the courses of I, II and III semesters till the IV semester examinations. However, he/she shall not be eligible to attend the courses of V semester until all the courses of I and II semesters are successfully completed.

A student shall be eligible to carry forward all the courses of III, IV and V semesters till the VI semester examinations. However, he/she shall not be eligible to attend the courses of VII semester until all the courses of I, II, III and IV semesters are successfully completed.

A student shall be eligible to carry forward all the courses of V, VI and VII semesters till the VIII semester examinations. However, he/she shall not be eligible to get the course completion certificate until all the courses of I, II, III, IV, V and VI semesters are successfully completed.

A student shall be eligible to get his/her CGPA upon successful completion of the courses of I to VIII semesters within the stipulated time period as per the norms specified in 26.

A lateral entry student shall be eligible to carry forward all the courses of III, IV and V semesters till the VI semester examinations. However, he/she shall not be eligible to attend the courses of VII semester until all the courses of III and IV semesters are successfully completed.

A lateral entry student shall be eligible to carry forward all the courses of V, VI and VII semesters till the VIII semester examinations. However, he/she shall not be eligible to get the course completion certificate until all the courses of III, IV, V and VI semesters are successfully completed.

A lateral entry student shall be eligible to get his/her CGPA upon successful completion of the courses of III to VIII semesters within the stipulated time period as per the norms specified in 26.

Any student who has given more than 4 chances for successful completion of I / III semester courses and more than 3 chances for successful completion of II / IV semester courses shall be permitted to attend V / VII semester classes ONLY during the subsequent academic year as the case may be. In simpler terms there shall NOT be any ODD BATCH for any semester.
